

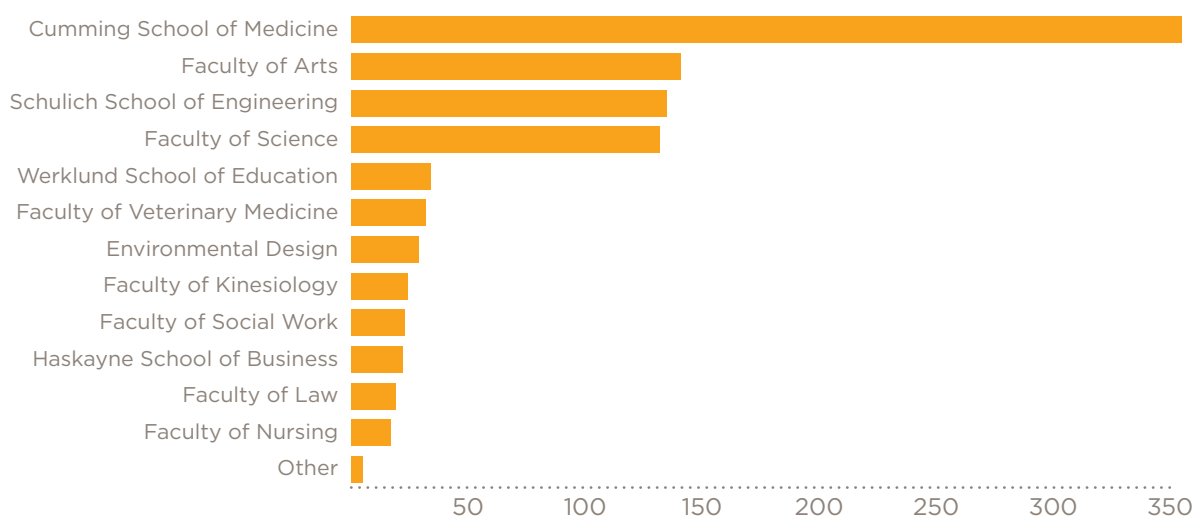

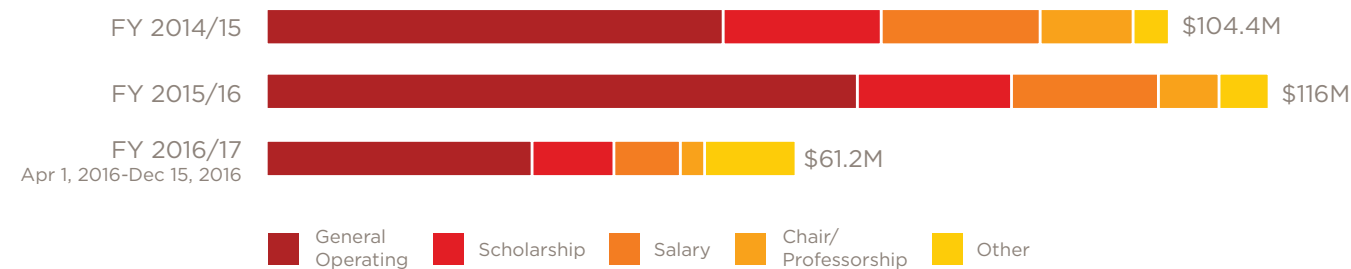

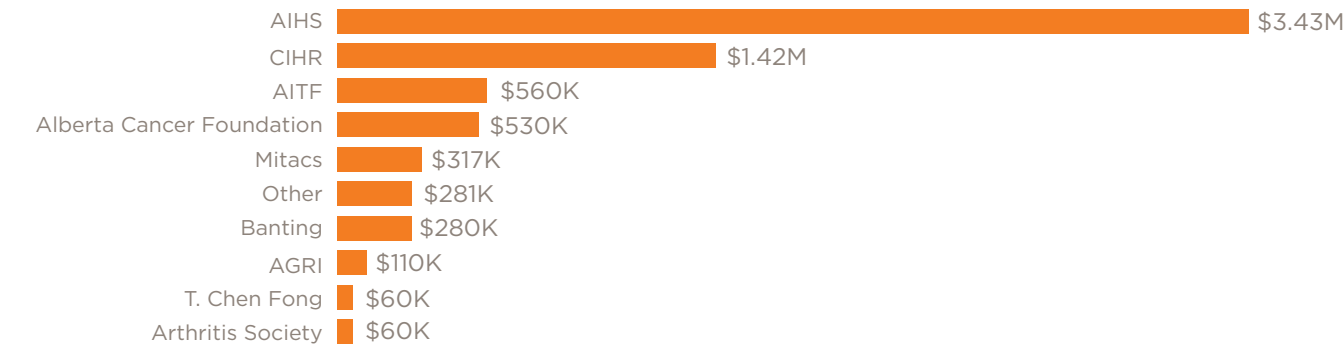
External research funding held by Deans and Department Heads
