

Field station Alcohol and Cannabis Policy

The University recommends that Students, Employees, Academic Staff Members, Appointees, Postdoctoral Scholars, and Visitors abstain from consuming alcohol while at Field Stations.

Students, Employees, Academic Staff Members, Appointees, Postdoctoral Scholars, and Visitors must limit alcohol consumption at Field Stations so that they do not become Impaired.

Then alcohol is consumed at a Field Station, the University representative in charge of the group or event at the Field Station must:

- a) Abstain from consuming alcohol;
- b) Identify at least 1 designated driver who will abstain from alcohol consumption, for each vehicle at the Field Station. The designated drivers must have appropriate permissions and licenses to drive the vehicle for which they will be the designated driver;
- c) Ensure at least 1 individual with first aid training abstains from consuming alcohol; and
- d) Maintain appropriate controls for any firearms at the Field Station.

Cannabis, in any form, is prohibited at Field Stations.
