I found an injured, orphaned, or dead animal. Who should I call?

There are many organizations throughout Alberta that can help. Each have different facilities, resources, and permits to care for different species.

Alberta Birds of Prey Foundation (403) 331-9520 | Coaldale, AB

- Focus on birds of prey, but will take all other birds
- Rescue, rehabilitation, and release
- Southern Alberta, but will accept from elsewhere

Alberta Society of Injured Birds of Prey (780) 922-3024 | Sherwood park, AB

- Focus on birds of prey
- Rescue, rehabilitation, and release
- Northern Alberta

Cochrane Ecological Institute (403) 932-5632 | Cochrane, AB

- First choice for moose, deer, elk (calves), bison, black bear cubs, and swift foxes. - Also accept all other non-banned species*
- Rescue, rehabilitation, and release

- Bobcats, adult skunks, migratory birds, and all others not on the banned species list*, except for bear cubs

- Most of these locations can perform necessary euthanasia on any animal.

If unsure which organization to call, choose the closest location that can

help the specific animal. If one organization is already on its way to help, do not call another one.
