[Abstract Submission Eligibility Policies and Regulations](#)

To be eligible to submit an abstract you must meet the following:

- 1) Registered full time student at the following Canadian universities
  - a. Universities of Calgary, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Lethbridge
- 2) Student(s) from other Universities may be considered on case by case basis and will be at the discretion of the Faculty Conference Chairs; however, they must be a student currently enrolled in a Canadian Institution only.
- 3) All students must submit the research abstract that they are currently working on towards their current degree.
- 4) All students who submit an abstract and are awarded the opportunity to present a podium or poster at the conference **MUST** present their own work. If you cannot attend the conference to present your abstract, then you will forfeit your spot to present and we will fill this spot with the next available student.
- 5) Students who offered a podium or poster presentation are to register and be available to present for the entire duration of the conference. The organizing committee will assign your date and time of presentation so you will need to be available during all presentation times.

**VERY IMPORTANT**

1. Abstract submission **including diagrams and/or photos** MUST be on ONE (1) PAGE
2. Format file must be in PDF **only**.
3. File name must be: YOURLASTNAME, 1<sup>st</sup> Name-2021
4. Ensure that your final abstract data and diagrams **do not expand into a 2<sup>nd</sup> page**
5. Students are allowed to upload ONE time and should be their final version. Please ensure that you carefully double check your abstract before uploading your final version. If we see multiple uploads from the same student we will automatically take the first submission regardless.

***Abstract will be not be accepted if you do not meet any of the above stated criteria.***
