
Extremism Online

Violent Extremism, Innovation, And Recruitment In The Metaverse – This report examines the way that recruiters for extremist causes could utilize the nascent metaverse, augmenting traditional techniques with digital capabilities such as haptic feedback gloves and augmented reality devices. The authors suggest the development of effective solutions to avert developments of concern in this new blended environment are dependant upon a clear conceptualization of this new space and associated governance mechanisms, Center for Research and Evidence on Security Threats.
