OVERVIEW

- SSHRC Destination Horizon Grants: support researchers affiliated with eligible Canadian postsecondary institutions
 - Build capacity
 - Foster existing partnerships
 - ➤ Further develop networks and/or consortia with European Union and other Associated Countries

KEY CHARACTERISTICS

Value	\$15,000
Duration	1 year
Frequency	3 deadlines per year (January 22, May 22, September 22) until January 2027
Participants	Single researcher or teams of researchers; no partner organizations
Matching Funds	100% cash contribution from host institution
Number of Awards	27 awards available for the January 2025 competition; 5 per each subsequent competition
Institutional Limits	3 applications per institution per competition
Individual Limits	An individual may apply multiple times per year, but once an individual has an award they may not apply again

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- ➤ The <u>eligibility requirements</u> comprise:
 - ☑ Eligible affiliation and primary discipline in the social sciences or humanities
 - Readiness to further develop networks and/or consortia
 - □ Eligible budget requests as per the <u>Tri-Agency Guide on</u>
 □ <u>Financial Administration</u>
 - ≥ 100% matching cash contributions from host institution

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- To be submitted on the <u>Convergence</u> platform
- Project Description
- - → Budget Justification
- ➤ Funds from Other Sources
- △ Applicant CV

SELECTION PROCESS

- → Eligibility Review
 - SSHRC staff will determine eligibility
- Nandomized Selection Process
 - → All eligible applications will have random number assigned to them
 - ☑ Grants will be selected in order from smallest random number to largest random number until financial resources are exhausted
