Transdisciplinary scholarship at UCalgary connects researchers and community to address challenges across five areas: cities and societies, digital worlds, health and life, energy futures, and democracy, justice, and sustainability.

Entrepreneurial thinking is a tool that supports our research community to take initiative, exchange knowledge across disciplines, learn from experience, and resourcefully engage with creative and cultural literacy.

Making an Impact

As Canada's entrepreneurial university, UCalgary is attracting top talent and investment from around the world with \$588M in externally funded research revenue in 2023-24 and \$632M in 2024-25.

UCalgary is Canada's youngest top five research university¹ and member of the U15 Group of Canadian Research Universities.

A top startup creator, UCalgary has launched 105 research-based companies, more than any other university in Canada in the last six years².

UCalgary is a Top 100 university ranked for entrepreneurs by PitchBook. Since 2014, UCalgary has produced 189 founders with an undergraduate degree who have raised a collective \$3.4B in capital³.
