Research and discovery are the foundation of innovation, and UCalgary innovation is creating positive outcomes and value for our communities. We are accelerating our innovation efforts through transdisciplinary scholarship and entrepreneurial thinking.

Transdisciplinary scholarship at UCalgary encourages and enables researchers to address challenges across five areas: cities and societies, digital worlds, health and life, energy futures, and democracy, justice and sustainability.

Entrepreneurial thinking is a tool that supports our research community to take initiative, exchange knowledge across disciplines, learn from experience, and resourcefully engage with creative and cultural literacy.

Making an Impact

UCalgary is the No. 1 startup creator among research institutions in Canada for three years in a row¹.

Over \$545.3 million in externally funded research revenue in 2022-23.

Since 2013, university research has led to over 1097 IP disclosures, 197 new patent applications filed, and 183 technology licenses/options executed.

University Innovation Quarter

UCalgary is creating physical space dedicated to innovation and creativity with the University Innovation Quarter (UIQ). UIQ will help build, develop, and scale solutions, policies, research, and inventions, while creating a complete ecosystem that brings community, researchers, entrepreneurs, and investors together in a transdisciplinary approach to foster and support the innovation process in Calgary.

Innovate Calgary

The innovation transfer and business incubator centre for the university, Innovate Calgary works closely with researchers, faculty, and students from ideation to commercialization.

Social Innovations with Community Impact

At UCalgary, not all research-based innovations lead to a commercialization pathway. There is a myriad of support available within the UCalgary innovation ecosystem to connect academic expertise with community members to address social change or launch a social enterprise. Support is provided through the Social Innovation Initiative and Innovate Calgary's Social Innovation Hub.



UCeed

A series of early-stage investment funds, backed by philanthropic support, accelerating early-stage startup companies to advance problem-solving research, create jobs and fuel the economy. UCeed funds, trains, mentors, and supports startup companies during the critical transitional stage between innovation demonstration and commercialization.
